#### DEEP DIVE: INCLUSIVENESS



#### **INCLUSIVE POLICIES**

Energy policies are redistributive and promote practices to reduce energy bills. Wider social policies support vulnerable consumers. Cross-sectoral dialogues help to identify policy solutions for vulnerable consumers.

#### **INCLUSIVE PRACTICES AND ENERGY JUSTICE**
