# Context & history of KORRR

### KORRR context



- KORRR =
  - Key Organisational Requirements, Roles and Responsibilities related to data exchange:
  - → a methodology according to Art. 40(6) System Operation GL
- All EU TSOs' proposal developed by ENTSOE, reviewed & ultimately approved by NRAs
- Definition of a common framework for data exchange between parties mainly for operational security analysis of the electric system
- Complements the GLDPM\* (Art. 16 CACM, referring to data exchange up to D-1) by including data exchange up to real time
- KORRR establishes a minimum level of harmonization, but also provides sufficient room for national / regional specificities and details on data exchange among parties as provided by SO GL

#### **KORRR delimitation & links**



Art. 40(5) SOGL:

TSOs to determine **data exchange applicability & scope** (in coordination with DSOs/SGUs) & NRAs to approve it nationally [→ for instance done by BNetzA for DE on 20.12.2018]



Art. 40(6) SOGL: KORRR = EU methodology



Art. 40(7) SOGL:

TSOs to agree with DSOs on **processes & format** for data exchange (incl. on DS/SGU data, if necessary); no NRA approval required [→ for instance done & published by TSOs in DE in March '19]



# Main content of KORRR & recalling NRAs' RfA

#### KORRR content



KORRR establishes rights & responsibilities on data exchange



TSO ←→ TSO direct communication

(on changes in protection settings, thermal limits, technical capacities at interconnectors)

- DSO → TSO
- DSO ←→ DSO
- SGU → TSO/DSO

information on changes in data (pursuant to Title 2 "Data Exchange" of the SO GL)

### KORRR - Recalling NRAs' RfA



Approved final
KORRR
included all
points made
by NRAs in
their Request
for
Amendment
in Q3/18, such
as:

- specifying cases for sharing confidential data among TSOs
- removing hurdles for reciprocity of data exchange
- TSOs to share un/planned unavailability of network elements with SGUs
- list & format for content of **Real Time data** to be published by TSOs
- limiting review of structural data to connected SGUs (and not all PGMs)
- readapting advance notice period for changes in structural data to 3 months
- including SGUs in **coordination** of **format specification** for structural data exchange
- other changes to improve clarity & accuracy

# Conclusions & next steps

### KORRR conclusions & next steps



✓ KORRR provides some harmonisation, but also sufficient room for national specificities in relation to data exchange between TSOs/DSOs/SGUs

(flexibility e.g. on data exchange models (direct/cascading), TSO/DSO relationship, data granularity / quality checks, responsibility for communication links etc.)

#### Implementation is key!

As ENTSOE's initial Implementation Monitoring (IM) in Q4/20 shows  $(\rightarrow cf. ENTSOE presentation)$ , national implementation of KORRR and of Art. 40(5) & (7) SO GL requirements is (still) not yet completed by all TSOs

- <u>Request</u>: Individual IM results (per TSO) to be shared by ENTSOE with ACER/NRAs
- <u>Proposal</u>: ACER / NRAs to follow up on implementation monitoring
